

**CAWSTON PARISH COUNCIL CEMETERY**

**FEES FOR 2023/2024**

**Fees, Payments and Sums fixed and settled**  
**under Section 15 of the Local Authorities**  
**Cemeteries Order 1977**

The residential fees, payments and sums set out in Parts 1 to 3 apply where the deceased person is an inhabitant of the **Civil Parish** of Cawston, or in the case of still-born children where the parents (or one of them) are such inhabitants.

For the purpose of determining fees, an inhabitant of Cawston is a person who is listed on the current Register of Electors. Former inhabitants who, at time of death, were resident in a retirement home located outside Cawston will be treated as inhabitants if they are listed on the current or previous four years Registers of Electors.

**PART 1 - INTERMENTS**

1. For interment in an earthen grave not exceeding 9 feet by 4 feet:-		
(i) of the body of a still-born child, or still-born twins (in one coffin) or a child whose age at time of death did not exceed one year.	No fee	No fee
(ii) of the body of a child whose age at time of death exceeded one year but did not exceed 18 years.	No fee	No fee
(iii) of the body of a person, whose age at time of death exceeded 18 years.	162.00	324.00
For interment of cremated remains in a grave in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted, or within that part of the Cemetery set aside for such remains.	114.00	204.00

**The fees indicated for the above heads of Part 1 DO NOT include the digging of the grave to a depth not exceeding 8 feet.**

**PART 2 – EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES**

1. For the exclusive right of burial, for a period of 100 years, in an earthen grave not exceeding 9 feet by 4 feet:-		
(i) purchased at or before the time of the first interment	144.00	288.00
(ii) purchased subsequent to the first interment	192.00	390.00
2. For the exclusive right of burial, for a period of 100 years, for the interment of cremated remains in that part of the Cemetery set aside for that purpose:		
(i) purchased at or before the time of the first interment	102.00	204.00
(ii) purchased subsequent to the first interment	120.00	240.00

**In the interests of economic management of the Cemetery the allocation of graves for new interments and the advanced purchase of exclusive rights of burial will be made by the Clerk of the Council in strict rotation within the area of the Cemetery in current use.**

**PART 3 – MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES AND INSCRIPTIONS**

1.	For the right to erect or place on a grave <b>in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted:-</b>		
(i)	a flat stone not exceeding 7 feet by 3 feet.	114.00	234.00
(ii)	a headstone not exceeding 5 feet in height.	114.00	240.00
(iii)	an inscribed vase of metal or stone.	60.00	120.00
(iv)	a headstone base, with or without vase, or scroll, book or recumbent across not exceeding 3 feet wide.	84.00	174.00
(v)	a cremation tablet not exceeding 1 foot 6 inches by 1 foot 3 inches.	99.00	180.00
(vi)	for each additional on a memorial.	69.00	144.00
